Daytime Entry

When the Day Time window is closed without a Schedule entered, the Day Time entry will be deleted. This applies to Day Time entries for Phones, Contacts and Operator Actions.

Site Search

'Matching Devices Only' flag has been added to Search options. When an Xmit# or Alt Device ID is entered, the search will only return device matches and not all devices on a matching Site.

When searching on Xmit#, Site Name, or SiteID1, the Exact Match will be at the top of the results.

The results display whether the device has a schedule.

History and Recent History

The More and Previous buttons on each line have been removed. The next page and previous page on the header will go to more or previous history from the highlighted line.

The Map Button displays independently of the other possible buttons (URL, Video, Audio, SMS, Email...)

The fields in the Flyout have been rearranged to prevent the Flyout from being cut off on top or bottom of the window.

Abort Group

'By Point' option has been added to Abort Group. When applied, the Abort Event must have the same point as the Alarm Event to abort the alarm.

Site Summary

Site Group Code words display on the Alarm Dispatch window after the Site Code words.

Option added to Site Group Type to not display the Site Group in the site group list on Alarm Dispatch, Data Entry Summary, Site Activate Title, and Quick Call.

Device Configuration

A link has been added to add a Device Comment in a big-text field. The Comment has been added to the Flyout in History.

Escalating Timer Test

Options have been added to the Event Code setup to facilitate an Escalating Timer Test. Additional events can be created with a Related Event Code and an Escalate Interval Count. When the Fail Timer Test is processed, it will look back to the "Last Timer Test" and count the fail timer test signals since.

In the Example below, "FailTTE2" has a Related Event Code of FailTTE and an Escalate Interval of 2; "FailTTE5" has a Related Event Code of FailTTE and an Escalate Interval of 5.

Contacts

When linking existing contacts to a site a problem finding contacts with no last name has been corrected.

No Activity Report and Short Site Device Report

City, Agency and Zip Code have been added to the Report Parameters.

External Application

Adding a new Device to a Site refreshes the Site Data window.
