## Site Group Site Audit

The system-wide (Default) Site Audit rules can now be overridden at the Site Group level. New securables for this functionality are **SiteGroupSiteAudit** and **SiteGroupSiteAuditWrite**.

## Site Notify Codes

Notify Codes can now be assigned at the Site level from the Site Detail window. The Site Notify Codes will be used to determine when Site Phones and Site Email Addresses are used on Auto Processes with the Site Notify Option of "Notify Code List Only".
